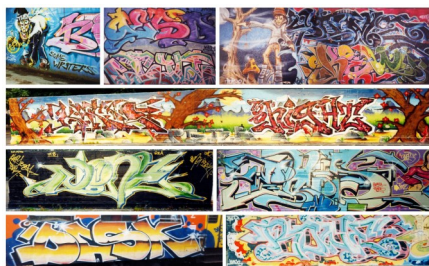


## KGIA Welcome
